Weybridge Sailing Club is situated on an interesting reach of the River Thames, adjacent to Shepperton Lock and the confluence with the River Wey and the Wey Navigation. The Club is easily reached from Walton or Weybridge via Walton Lane which joins the two towns and follows the river from Walton Bridge to Thames Street in Weybridge.

The Club was established in its present form in 1963 and the premises include a large dinghy park with hard standing for some 50 boats, which are fenced off from the river towpath and the road. The Club buildings consist of a clubhouse, boat shed and starters hut. Limited toilets facilities are available on the site.

Organised races are arranged through the year generally on Sunday afternoons from April to November. The Club operates a safety boat which is in attendance during the course of racing.

Weybridge Sailing Club is a friendly local social boating club appealing to members of all ages. The Club has ample off street parking with no traffic jams.

The stretch of the river that is available for sailing is not suitable for serious competitive racing due to the presence of high trees and cruiser boats entering and leaving Shepperton lock. Our aim is to attract members who either no longer wish to take part in competitive races, are not interested in serious racing or just like pottering about on the river.

Because of the attractive surroundings and large open grassed area the Club especially appeals to family members with young children.

The Club has facilities for boat maintenance including a large secure shed with power and lighting.
